- Creates and adjusts patterns using Gerber AccuMark (PDS), or digitizes patterns using a digitizing table.
- Manages and oversees the sample making process of a product.
- Organizes and leads fit sessions, with the ability to identify fit issues as well as communicating appropriate recommendations.
- Provides and recommends alternative solutions to improve the design, quality and construction of products, while at the same time upholding design intent, production efficiencies and product costs.
- Builds and maintains technical specification packets including; technical flat drawings, product details, construction steps and time studies, fabrics, trims and notions, as well as sample measurements for quality standard and size chart information. Also needs to document all changes throughout the entire product development process.
- Creates, updates and organizes cost sheets for Management.
- Uses Gerber AccuMark software for grading.
- Creates markers utilizing Gerber AccuMark and AccuNest software, as well as preparing digital templates for graphic artist and production use.
- Prepares hard patterns and digital cut files for production use.
- Arranges for products to hit production, by entering the appropriate components, consumption and time into our ERP system for inventory control and production workflow.
- Collaborates with Marketing team to educate Customer Sales Representatives and Production leads on new and revised products.
